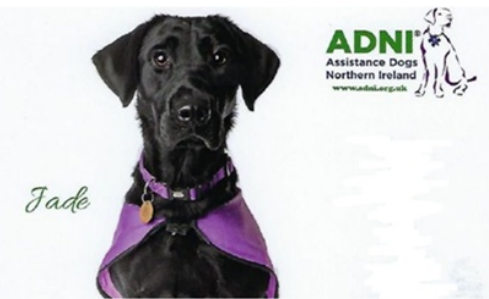
CSSC Building Capacity programme 2020

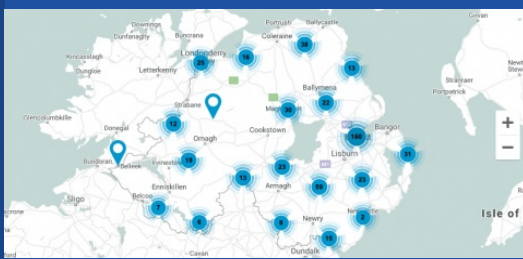
Breakfast Club Funding available
