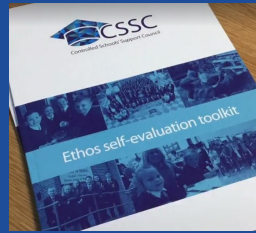

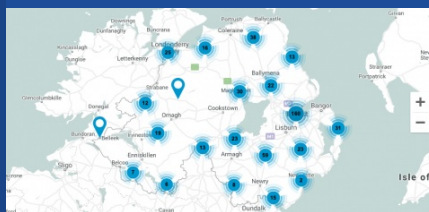
### Strabane Primary prize giving ceremony
