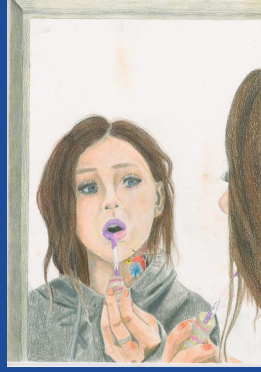
Access up to £3,000 for STEM projects
