Lending digital devices to pupils and broadband solutions – EA Update

EA have procured a further 14,000 devices for eligible pupils in priority groups and are extending this to other year groups (where possible). The scheme remains open to request devices for pupils who meet the criteria and do not have sufficient access to a device to support their learning. Solutions for broadband access are also available for eligible pupils across all year groups.
